## THE ASSOCIATION'S BUDGET AND SUBSCRIPTIONS 2007-2008

### Report by the Director

---

#### RECOMMENDATION

That the subscription unit of £2,100 agreed at the January meeting be confirmed for the year 2007/2008.

---

1. The Association approved its budget and subscriptions for 2007/8 in January. The budget is met by the payment of "subscription units" from member authorities. The New Forest National Park Authority pays one unit; District Councils, the Police Authority and the Hampshire Fire and Rescue Authority each pay two units; Unitary Councils pay three units and the County Council pays four units. In addition, Associations of Parish and Town Councils pay £1 per parish.
2. The approved budget is slightly higher than that for 2006/2007 as a result of inflation. The proposed subscription increase of 2.4% is slightly less than the current level of inflation. The proposed subscriptions for 2007-2008 are as follows:
